### **City Issues Stormwater Management Guide For HOA's**



The City's new Land Development Manager and acting Stormwater Director, Tom Roberts, has recently issued a memo directing Homeowners Associations Board members to the City's Stormwater Management Program guidebook.

The guidebook is intended to assist HOAs to "Identify your type of facility and understand its unique maintenance needs," "Define tasks required for

maintenance," "Identify costs and allocate your resources" among other several other key points.

Mr. Roberts memo states "that since the turnover from the original developer at the conclusion of construction, many organizations, for a variety of reasons, do not realize they have maintenance responsibilities for the ponds serving their communities".
