Police News/PACT Program

Each year brave men and women of the Johns Creek Police Department attend our Annual Meeting. This year however they are unable to attend as they are rolling out their new PACT (Police and Community Together) Program. This is a great program for each HOA to be involved with. The JCPD is compiling a database of HOA board members for quick community communication and easy distribution of information to subdivisions. We'll have



a sign up sheet at the annual meeting for any neighborhoods that are interested in signing up.

The JCPD is also happy to announce two new direct phone lines. <u>D.I.Y. Alarm Line</u>. So what does this mean? If you are out of the city and your home video camera shows someone suspicious at your door, or your unmonitored alarm goes off, you have a direct line to report the incident. In the past, you would have to call 911 and ask whatever jurisdiction you were in to transfer you to Johns Creek — losing valuable time. You can now call and tell the dispatcher immediately what is happening. Call 404-843-6680.

Non-emergency Phone Line. Use if you are out of the city and need to contact the police department. Call 404-843-6680. If you need police assistance while in JC, please call 911 as normal.


Autrey Mill Seeks Docents

Autrey Mill Nature Preserve and Heritage Center is looking for docent volunteers for the 2019-2020 season.
