The coronavirus pandemic is affecting all of us in one way or another and you, as HOA board members, can be an important vehicle in reinforcing the message of social distancing in your communities to help flatten the curve and limit the spread of the virus.

SBA Loans: Small businesses can apply for Small Business Disaster relief funds <u>here</u>. Most small businesses are eligible and it is recommended that you apply immediately. Read a quick overview of SBA loans <u>here</u>.

SNAP benefits for all current recipients have been extended through June 2020. Apply for SNAP benefits <u>here</u>.

The Georgia Department of Labor is providing online access to unemployment services, partial claim access for employers and other reemployment services. File unemployment and other claims <u>here</u>.


