Emory Johns Creek Hospital will offer free health screenings at its annual 5K Scrub Run and Community Health Festival on Saturday, May 18.

Free health screenings will be available including: cholesterol, glucose, blood pressure and body mass index (BMI) calculations starting at 8 a.m. Physicians will offer casual consultations to attendees.



Registration opens at 6:30 a.m. The run and walk will kick off at 8 a.m. followed by the Fun Run at 9 a.m. for children ages 10 and under.

An awards ceremony and raffle will take place after race participants finish the course. This family-friendly event will also include face painting for children, a bouncy house, free food, music and access to dozens of community vendors.

The event will also feature a ribbon cutting ceremony to celebrate Leadership Johns Creek's project for a new adaptive vehicle at Emory Johns Creek Hospital. This project will help people with mild cognitive impairments, injuries and disabilities drive safely.
